Mission & Objectives:	Casa Alianza GC raises money for an international, non-governmental organization in Honduras, dedicated to the rehabilitation and defense of 12,000 street children a year. Orphaned, abused or abandoned, most of these children are further traumatized by the indifference of the societies in which they live. The organization is a place where forgotten children can escape from hunger, drugs, poverty, prostitution, emotional starvation and physical danger. Instead they receive shelter, food, medical care, protection, guidance, respect and love.

Reasons Project was Adopted (please describe):	A former UWCSEA student from Central America saw the need to create a global concern that dealt with issues regarding children from that region, particularly Honduras. Instead of starting a whole new project in Honduras, Casa Alianza GC was set up in UWC to contribute to the existing Casa Alianza organization - an group that helps care for and rehabilitate street children not just in Honduras but countries around the region as well such as Guatemala and Mexico.
